
How to add Members to API-Central

How to add members in ADP® API Central

Welcome to ADP API Central!! The following guide will help you add team members to work on your integration projects.

Adding Members

When you access ADP API Central at <u>api-central.adp.com</u>, by default you'll land on the **Members** page. This is where you can add internal or external team members to assist with your integration projects and assign their roles, including the ability to initiate their own projects.



How to add internal members. Click the Add internal member button and search for the member of your organization you'd like to add. Internal members must be registered users on your ADP platform.





How to add members in ADP® API Central

Once you locate and select the new member from your search, you must assign their user role(s). Note: You must select at least one role for each member. Then select the **Add button** to complete the process.



How to add external members

You may add external users to API Central, who may be a vendor or technical resource that will be working on the integration project utilizing the ADP APIs.

- Click the **Add external member** button, located below your list of internal members.
- Fill out the required contact information and assign their user roles as before and click **Save**.



Add external member

This process will create ADP credentials to access both API Central and the developer's website. Note that the username will be displayed for members in this section; username is first initial, last name @"Client Database ID".




How to create a Project in API-Central

How to create a project in ADP® API Central

Welcome to ADP API Central! This guide will help you create an integration project.

Access ADP API Central at <u>api-central.adp.com</u>. Navigate to the **Projects** tab. Then select the **Create a project** button.



In the pop-up window, add your project name and description, then click **Next**.




Note: Projects cannot be deleted — so consider your naming convention accordingly. Project descriptions are optional.


On the next screen, select the use case that best describes the type of data you are trying to access, then click **Create Project**. API Central will assign the appropriate APIs.



Note: The use cases listed are a starting point. They include the most popular APIs. After you create your project, you can add additional APIs by selecting the "Need more APIs" link in the user interface.

Once you have created a project it will be represented on your **Projects** page with a project card. Each project you create will be added to your **Projects** page. To access an individual project, select the **View project** button.



Note: All projects have the "Data connector" subhead.


How to manage Certificates in API-Central

How to create and manage certificates in ADP® API Central

Welcome to ADP API Central! Before you can start working on your projects, you must create a security certificate. This guide will help you create and manage certificates and tokens to enable your team to build integration projects.

Create a certificate: Select **Certificate** from the menu or click **View project** from the **Projects** menu and navigate to Step 1: Generate a security certificate for your organization. Select **Request Certificate** from the drop-down menu.









How to create and manage certificates in ADP® API Central

You will see the Certificate Wizard. Select **Next** on the Wizard.



Name your certificate and fill out your organization information. Select **Next**.


Copy your private key and save it to your computer.



Note: For security reasons, ADP can neither store nor retrieve your private key. Please save it to your computer. You will need this key to access the ADP APIs.


Once your certificate has been created, you will see the details on the certificate card including the generation date, the expiration date, a link to view or download the .pem file.



You will be notified before your certificate expires.

When your signed certificate is within 60 days of expiration, all individuals who have active status in the Members tab will receive multiple notifications at regular intervals until it has expired. If you would like to stop receiving certificate expiration notices, you may opt out by adjusting your settings.

How to set Workforce Now Permission

How to set ADP Workforce Now® access permissions for ADP® API Central

ADP API Central projects have access to data fields in ADP Workforce Now. This guide reviews the process of setting security access and profile permissions for projects using ADP API Masking for Sensitive Personal Information (SPI). This process must be done by a Workforce Now administrator. **By default, all SPI is masked**.

From the ADP Workforce Now console, you can view these settings by navigating to: Setup > Security > Access Permissions > Manage Profiles > Find the API Central Profile


Log in to ADP Workforce Now and click **Setup**.



Next click **Access Permissions** under the Security menu.



Click on **Manage Profile** under the Manage Profiles Permissions box.









Locate the API Central project name that was generated when you created your project in API Central and click on the name.



Click on the tab **2. Sensitive Personal Information**. All SPI is masked by default. If the data is needed in the API project output, you can update the settings and save.
