



To use ADP APIs, you should have a basic familiarity with the following:

- Software development
- Hypertext Transfer Protocol (HTTP)
- Representation State Transfer (RESTful) web services
- JavaScript Object Notation (JSON)
- Open Authorization (OAuth)

We will work with you to expose your ADP Workforce Now data through our RESTful APIs. But, it's up to you to write the middleware that utilizes them to fulfill your business needs.
