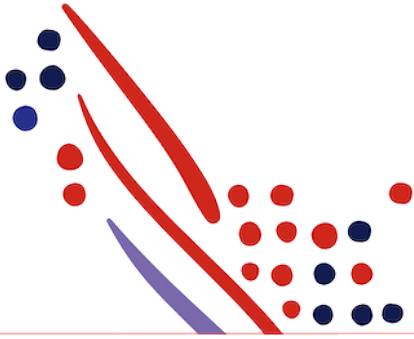

1. Clients can choose one of the below options at the time of subscription
 - o ADP Invoice (US Marketplace Only)
 - o Credit Card
2. ADP Invoice - Billing for the app will be added as another line item in the invoice.
3. Payment cycle
 - o Partner to provide their W-2 to ADP after they go live
 - o ADP collects payments from clients
 - o ADP remits partner's revenue share after excluding ADP revenue share
 - o Typical duration for remitting partner is 60-90 days.
