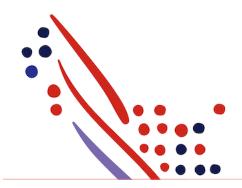

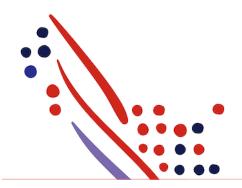

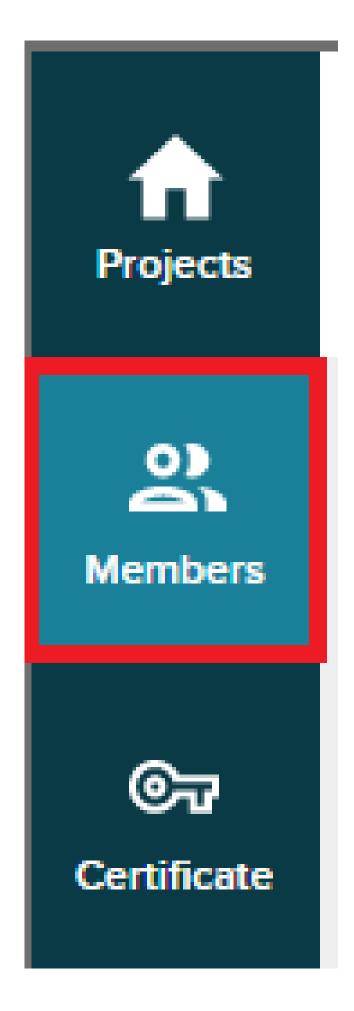

Un-Suspending an Account Using the Developer Self Service Portal

Any Developer can un-suspend another developers account by following the steps below.

1. Log into the the Developer Self Service Portal and on the left hand side click on "Members"



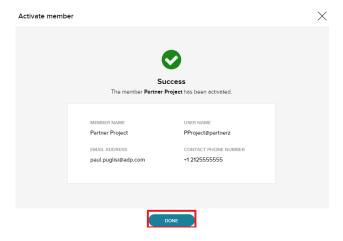
2. This will take you to members page below showing both Active and Suspended Members



3. Choose the member you want to un-suspend by clicking on the three dots on the right choosing "Activate Member"



4. This will bring up a success window wher you will then click on "Done"



5. The previously susupended user will now show up under the "Active Members" list and can now log into the Developer Self Service Portal.



Unlocking a Developers Account (Netsecure)

A partner administrator can unlock developers' account or reset their passwords.

Go to ADP's identity management system to manage developer accounts.

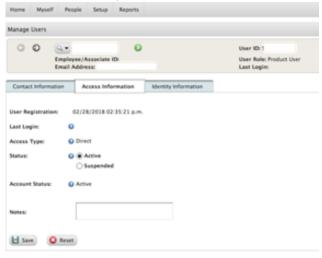
1. Log in as an administrator, then select People -> Manage Users.



2. Select the user and reset their password if requested.



3. OR select the user and update the status to Active (if it's suspended).



4. Then hit "Save".
